



ASAS Undergraduate Student Poster Presentation Information and Call for Abstracts

The purpose of the ASAS Undergraduate Student Poster Presentation is to encourage undergraduates to gain experience in the presentation of papers and to give them an opportunity to participate more fully in the scientific meeting of the ASAS. The purpose of these presentations is to provide an opportunity for undergraduate researchers to present their original research to a national scientific audience.

Eligibility: Contestants must be undergraduate members of ASAS who are enrolled in a program granting a baccalaureate degree or who have received a baccalaureate degree during the previous 7 months. There is no limit to the number of students from any single institution presenting at the meeting. However, a maximum of \$300 in travel funds will be awarded per institution to assist in undergraduate participation in the meeting.

Abstract Submission and Presentation: Abstract submission should follow the guidelines established for the Joint Annual Meeting and report the student's original research. The deadline for submission is **March 3, 2015**. Presentation will be the poster format established for the Joint Annual Meeting at a time designated by the Program Committee.

Recognition: The posters will be judged by a panel of professional members of ASAS. Based on the judges' decisions, prizes will be awarded for first (\$500), second (\$300), and third place (\$200). The winners will be announced at the ASAS awards program.
